ITALIAN AIRPORTS: GROWING NUMBER OF AIRPORTS WITH FREE WATER REFILL STATIONS FOR TRAVELLERS

Rome, 16 October 2025 – By the end of the year, 22 airports associated with Assaeroporti will offer departing passengers the opportunity to refill their bottles and flasks free of charge once past the security check points.

In response to Assaeroporti's call to action, several airports have joined Milan Malpensa and Linate, Naples, Bologna, Cagliari, Turin, Olbia and Alghero—where dispensers have long been available—by implementing or finalizing the installation of refill stations.

Among the most recent updates, refill points have been activated at Bergamo, Palermo and Cuneo airports. By the end of the year they will also be available at Catania, Pisa, Florence, Trieste, Trapani, Pescara, Rimini, Comiso and Salerno, further expanding national coverage. With different operating models but always at no cost to travellers, Genoa and Grosseto airports also guarantee access to drinking water in the airside area.

The initiative aims to enhance passengers' travel experience and contribute to the reduction of single-use plastic. It's a concrete action bringing benefits for the environment and the community, and promoting increasingly sustainable, traveller-friendly airports.
